Instructions for Wound Care

Shave Biopsy

A bandage has been placed over the biopsied site(s). Leave this in place for 24 hours.

Cleanse the area(s) daily with mild soap and water, apply plain Vaseline and keep covered with a bandage.

Punch Biopsy

Vaseline ointment and a bandage has been applied to the site. Continue to apply Vaseline to the wound until it is completely healed.

You can remove the bandage at any time, but you may prefer to keep the wound covered. Keeping the site covered with a bandage may prevent rubbing at the site and will also keep the Vaseline off your clothing.

Suture (stitches) are removed, usually about 7 to 10 days following the procedure.

Liquid Nitrogen

After liquid nitrogen treatment, your skin will become swollen and red and it may blister during the first 24 hours. Scab will form and will fall off by itself in one to three weeks.

Apply Vaseline until it is completely healed. Generally, no special care is needed after liquid nitrogen treatment.

If clothing irritates the area, cover it with a small bandage.

Please Note: If any bleeding is noted, apply pressure to the area for 15 minutes. If this does not stop the bleeding please call our office.
